### ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

#### For Elementary Students, use the following Marks:

- 4 – Advanced (Exceeds standards)
- 3 – Proficient (Meets Standards)
- 2 – Partially Proficient (Partially meets standards)
- 1 – Not Proficient (Does not meet/unable to meet standards)

#### For Life Skills Curriculum, use the following Marks:

- O – Outstanding
- G – Good
- S – Satisfactory
- N – Needs to Improve

#### For Secondary Students, use the following Grades:

- A – Produces markedly superior work.
- B – Produces superior work.
- C – Demonstrates satisfactory work.
- D – Needs to improve progress in work.
- F – Demonstrates little or no progress in work.

### WORK HABITS AND COOPERATION

#### For Elementary Students, use the following Marks:

- 4 – Strong (Always)
- 3 – Consistent (Usually)
- 2 – Inconsistent (Sometimes)
- 1 – Poor (Rarely)

#### For Secondary Students, including Life Skills Curriculum, use the following Marks:

- E – Excellent
- S – Satisfactory
- U – Unsatisfactory
