



# 11TH ANNUAL STAN CHAMBERS JOURNALISM AWARDS

**To Enter:** On a separate cover sheet please print your name, grade, age, address and daytime telephone number. Also print your teacher's name, class or department, school name, address and phone number.

**Entry:** Participants must submit an original essay incorporating the theme "What Matters Most" in your life. The essay must be 150 words or less and should be based on your experiences, thoughts and opinions about life. Only one entry per student is permitted. Entries shall become the property of KTLA and will not be returned.

**Eligibility:** Participants must be high school seniors. Employees of KTLA Inc., Tribune Company, their subsidiaries and their family members are not eligible to enter.

**Deadline:** The award program begins Monday, January 19, 2009. Entries must be received by midnight Thursday, March 19, 2009.

KTLA will not be responsible for entries lost or delayed in the mail.

**Selection of winners:** Five entries will be selected by a panel of professional KTLA News journalists. Each entry will be judged on originality, creativity and writing skills. Winners will be notified by mail and phone on or about April 13, 2009.

**Award:** Each of the five winners will receive a check for \$1000. In addition, each of the five award winners will have the opportunity to produce the entry's theme as a video essay for possible airing on the KTLA Prime News, and possible display on the ktl.com website. KTLA shall have final editorial approval and control over the video essay, and complete discretion as to whether and when to air the video essay (if at all). KTLA is under no obligation to air the video essay. Production of winner's themes will take place during the months of April and May 2009. Winners must be available to assist in the production of their video essay. Upon final approval by KTLA, finished video essays will air on KTLA Prime News during the month of June/July 2009. Awards are not transferable.

**Conditions of entry:** Decisions of the judges are final and binding. By entering, each entrant agrees to the use by KTLA of Award winner's name, voice, likeness and biographical information for publicity purposes in connection with the award program, without further compensation. All entries become the property of KTLA, and KTLA shall retain all rights in the video segment produced by the award winners. None of the essays nor the master tapes of the video segment shall be returned. The award will be forfeited and awarded to another entrant if the selected winner is not eligible in accordance with the rules. Winners and, if under the age of eighteen, their parent or legal guardian must sign an Affidavit of Eligibility and Release in order to receive the award. Taxes on the award are the winner's responsibility. All entries must be the entrant's own original work.
